



About Measurements

Don't worry about being perfect. These measurements are simply a starting point to help us understand your space and begin planning your project. Kitchen Concepts will verify all measurements before ordering any products or beginning construction.

What You'll Need: ☐ Tape Measure ☐ Pencil ☐ The Following Worksheet ☐ Camera or Smartphone

Step 1: Create a Simple Sketch

Draw a rough outline of the room. Start in one corner and work your way around the room in one direction, including: Walls. Windows. Doors. Existing appliances. Islands. Or other permanent features.

Step 2: Measure In Inches. Include:

- ☐ **Overall wall lengths:** Measure through all openings for an overall room dimension in all directions this should add up to all dimensions on each wall.
- ☐ **Ceiling height:** Measure the ceiling height in all four corners of the room and be sure to note the lowest point.
- ☐ **Window and door locations:** Measure all door and window openings from outside of trim (working wall space is what we need). Show which way door swings.
- ☐ **Plumbing and Electrical:** Measure electrical and plumbing through all openings for an overall room dimension in all directions this should add up to all dimensions on each wall.
- ☐ **Measure to the bottom of any soffits and windows from floor.** (Soffits are typically the boxy, drywalled space between the top of your upper cabinets and the ceiling).
- ☐ **Approximate sizes of existing appliances that will remain**
- ☐ **Any features that may affect the design** (soffits, columns, beams, angled walls, etc.)

Step 3: Take Photos

Photos can be extremely helpful. Please take pictures from several angles showing: ☐ The entire room ☐ Appliances ☐ Windows and doors ☐ Areas you like ☐ Areas you would like to improve

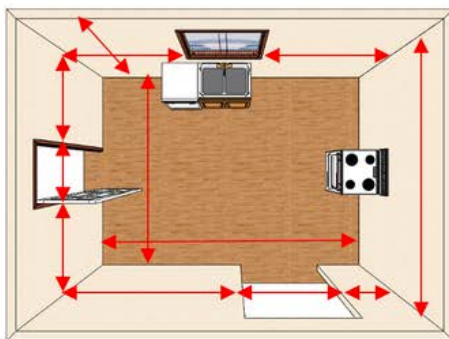

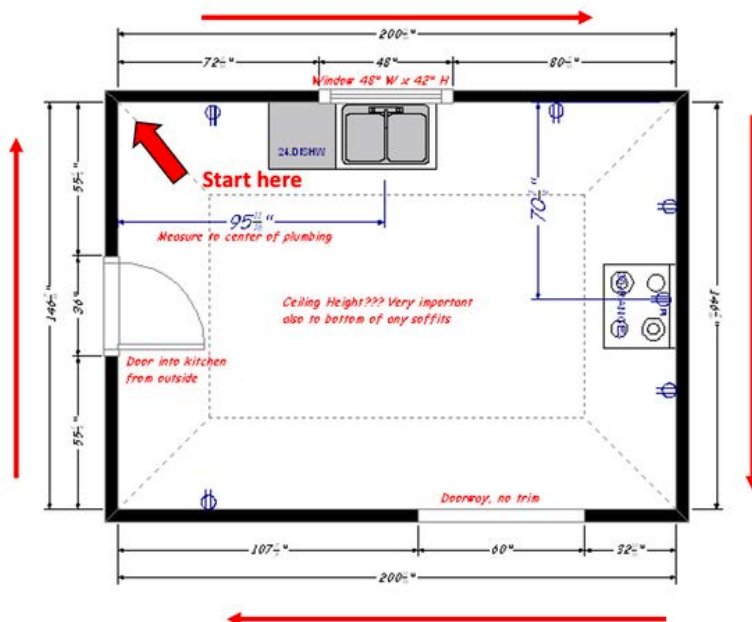
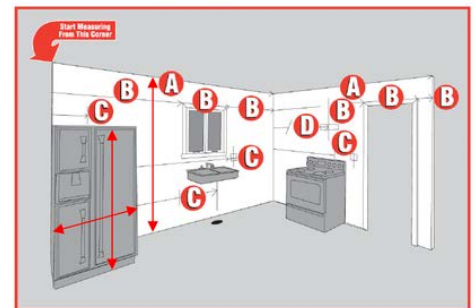

Resources and Examples



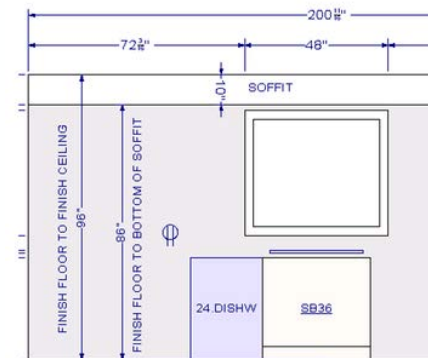
How to measure your area:

- A** Measure the complete length of each wall starting in the left corner. Record your measurements in inches on the grid at the right.
 - B** Show all the windows, closets, doorways, and fireplaces measuring from the left corner to the outside edges of the moulding.
 - C** Measure from the left corner to the center line of all sinks, water drains, gas lines and electrical outlets.
 - D** Mark the location of all permanent or remaining appliances and air vents.
- Check to be sure the total measurements of B equal A.
Note the ceiling height and the refrigerator width and height.



Helpful Tips

Measure twice & label your sketch clearly.
Don't worry about minor inaccuracies—we will verify all measurements before moving forward.
When in doubt, include photos and notes.
